

### CHURCH CHOIR

Until more recent years there was a large choir. The notes in 1921 give us information that choir salaries were £14.19.3d whereas the Church Insurance only cost £1.19.2½d. For many years there were 8 ladies and 10-12 men. Mrs. Peacock was the last lady member. The last male member of the choir was Mr. Frank Catling who retired in 1985. He had been Manager of the Church School in Hail Weston until 1966 and was Church Warden for 46 years. There is a plaque to his memory near the pew where he used to sit (under the North Window).

### MOTHERS UNION

The Mothers Union was founded in 1913 by Mrs. Charles Banks. It played an important part in the village and celebrated its fifty years in 1963. It sadly closed in the mid seventies.

The blue banner still, stands by the Altar in the Church.
